- Project entry forms and the judging rubric can also be found on the Heritage Tea page at fineartscenter.org. You or a school official designated by you must submit the information for your school's 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners via the link on page 2 of this letter that coincides with your school. *This is the only document containing these links.*
- Projects should be **delivered** to the Douglas Reed House of the Fine Arts Center of Kershaw County **by Tuesday, February 13, 2018** from 10:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. so that projects can be displayed and judged on the district level.
- Encourage the school finalists or send school representatives to pick up the projects at the *completion* of the **Heritage Tea** awards ceremony on **February 25, 2018**. This is approximately a 60-minute program beginning at 3:00 p.m.
- Send a school representative to pick up any remaining projects from the Fine Arts Center no later than 5:00 pm on Tuesday, March 6, 2018.

We look forward to seeing you at the Heritage Tea on Sunday, February 25, 2018, at 3:00 p.m. at the Fine Arts Center of Kershaw County. Please feel free to view all projects on display at the Douglas Reed House of the Fine Arts Center campus during the week leading up to the awards ceremony.
